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# INTRODUCTION

## Purpose

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The California Educator Reporting System (CERS) uses generic system element names in report column headers to represent the assessment testing data it contains. Many of the generic system element names are used across multiple subjects and assessments that may have their own naming conventions.

To assist users, this data dictionary provides a crosswalk between the predefined system element names and a specific subject or assessment naming conventions. Additionally, the data dictionary can be used to determine which reports contain specific elements and what values to expect in relation to the data element.

For information on interpreting data available in CERS, users are encouraged to review the Interpretative Guide or other assessment guidance provided to them. For information on creating the reports listed within this document, user interface (UI) displays, and system functionality, see the CERS User Guide.

## Document Organization

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### Section One: Data Elements

The first section lists the data elements alphabetically and identifies in which report they are found. The chart identifies the report type where each element is found. If a user knows the element they need, they should start in this section. Each element is hyperlinked to its definition in Section Three.

### Section Two: CERS Reports and Their Data Elements

The second section lists the various reports found within CERS, and what data elements are found in each report. This section assists a user in determining what elements are in a known report.

### Section Three: Defining the Data Elements

The third section contains information regarding each data element. The data elements are listed alphabetically and include the element's name, a description, and expected values for each assessment. This assists a user in understanding an element in relation to the assessment type, subject, and naming convention.

## Student Roster Exports

All Student Roster Exports begin in the same order. Columns A-Q in the CSV file will cover student and school identifying information, administration information, subject and assessment information, and overall scale scores with error bands.

Next, the report will list from left to right the alternate scores and then claim scores as appropriate for the assessment (columns vary based on assessment). If the user has multiple subjects displayed on screen, the columns for each level (alternate or claim scores) will be in the following order left to right on the CSV export: ELPAC, Math, English, Science.

The last twelve data elements will be student demographic information.

The Student Roster Exports Tables are listed based on which reports have the same data in the export from the least number of data elements to the most.

### IAs, IABs, CAAs, and CSA Student Roster Exports

All IAs, IABs, all CAAs, and the CSA have the same reported data elements.
