Handwriting practice lines for the number 5, consisting of a solid top line, a dashed middle line, and a solid bottom line.

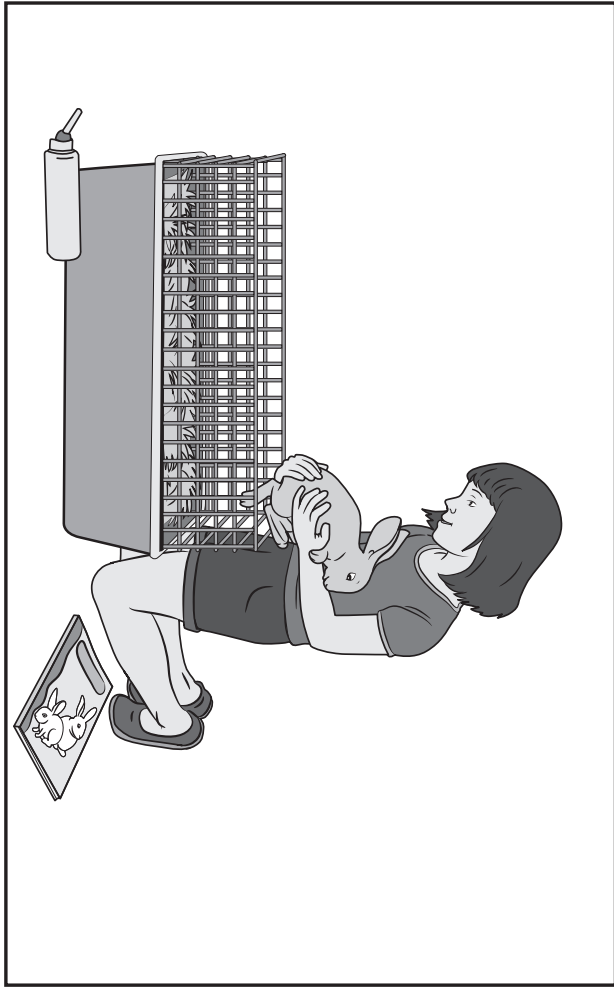
