
Organization of the California Alternate Assessment for Science

The California Alternate Assessment (CAA) for Science is an untimed, computer-based assessment administered to students with the most significant cognitive disabilities whose individualized education program indicates the use of an alternate assessment. The assessment is aligned with alternate achievement standards—called the Science Core Content Connectors—which are linked to the performance expectations from the California Next Generation Science Standards. Eligible students take the assessment in grades five and eight and once in high school (grade ten, eleven, or twelve).

This assessment consists of three separate, embedded performance tasks (PTs). Each PT contains fifteen test questions specific to one of the three science domains, which are Earth and Space Sciences, Life Sciences, and Physical Sciences. Each PT assesses three Connectors. Each Connector segment includes an orienting activity followed by five questions at three levels of increasing complexity.

Administer each of the three performance tasks at any time throughout the year!



Test examiners administer the three embedded PTs in any order, at any time, throughout the school year. Each PT is administered to the student in a one-on-one setting by a trained test examiner shortly after the student has received instruction on the related science content.
